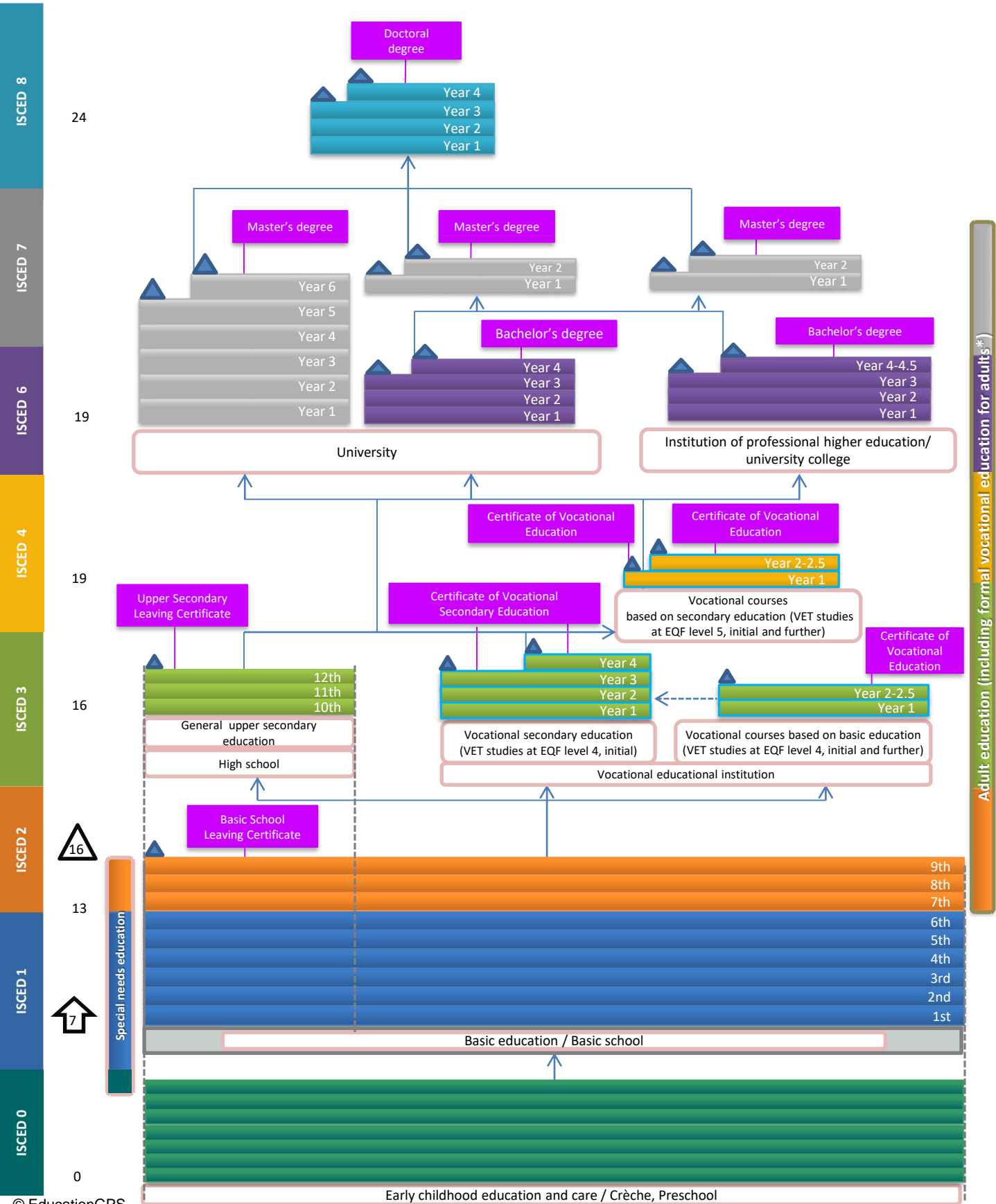

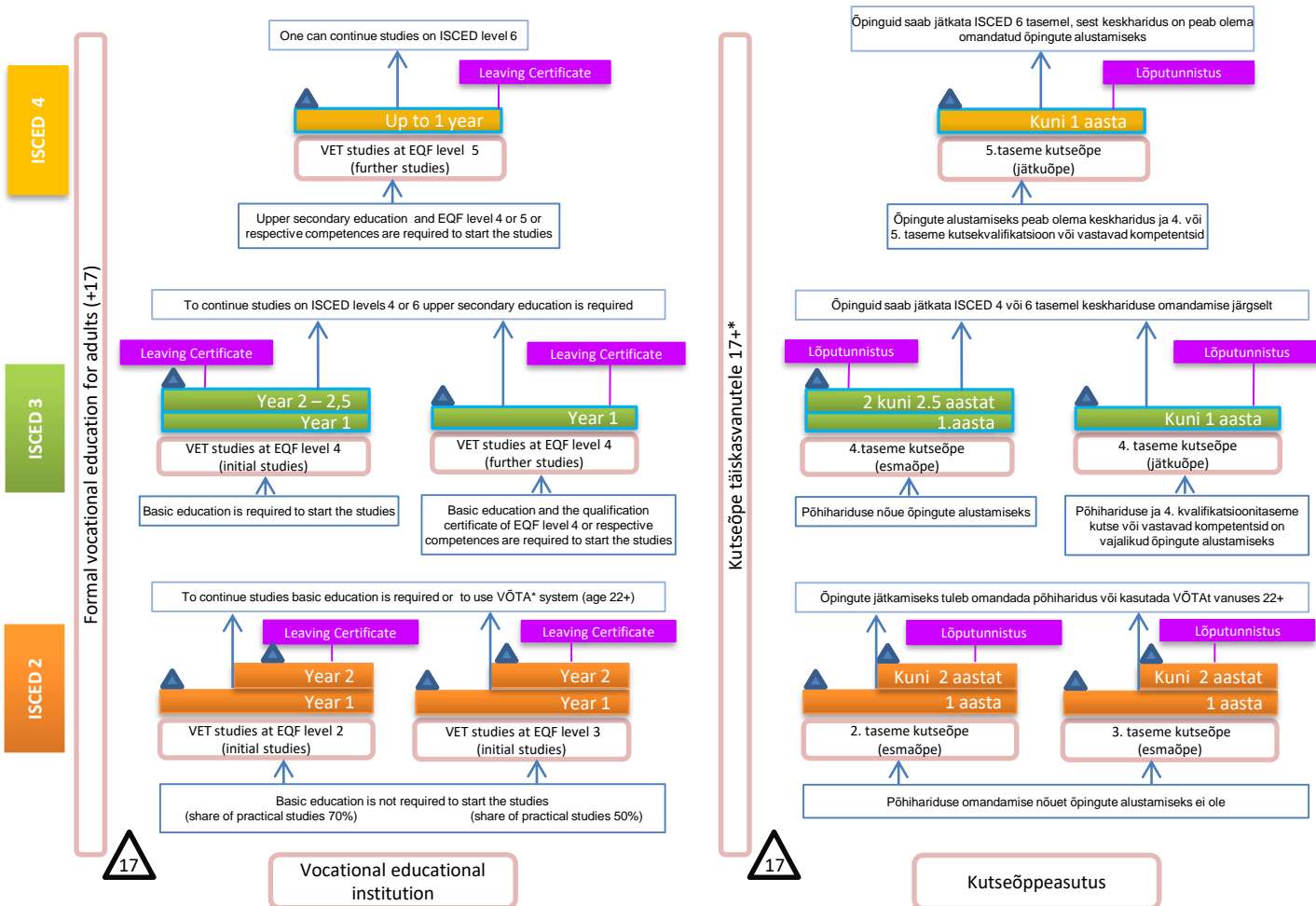

## Note on Estonian education system

Formal vocational education in Estonia uses the EQF qualification scale and is identified to ISCED levels. However, these programmes do not have a specific requirement of age. Vocational education studies leading to EQF levels 2 and 3 (initial, without basic education requirement) and levels 4 and 5 (initial and further education with specific EQF level requirement) are represented below.
